## What

Porto will host the premiere edition of a full scale international Scala conference in Southwest Europe. A superset of leading Scala experts from across the world will discuss the current and future trends around the programming language and its ecosystem.

## When

On Tuesday June 20<sup>th</sup> the event activities begin with the hands on specialization workshops and continue on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> of June with an open source contribution hackathon led by Scala Center institute.

On Wednesday June 21<sup>st</sup>, the registrations will open at 16:00 and the Welcoming keynote at 18:00, followed by two full session days on Thursday June 22<sup>nd</sup> and Friday June 23<sup>rd</sup>. The conference closes with an introduction to the Sao Joao festival.

An additional networking opportunity is during the Post conference excursion on Saturday June 24<sup>th</sup> including private boat cruise and Port wine caves visit.



## Why

As a group of altruists determined to establish the missing collective synapse and bridge the gaps between communities, our aim is to propel dormant ideas and make them thrive in the already vibrant Scala community.

Our long term commitment is to awaken the potential and further inspire development of the new paradigm beyond technical limitations and raise the collective social awareness. We believe Porto has the potential of becoming such a hub.

This conference is organized by Scala altruists and BeeScala organizers (another international Scala conference) in association with MediaClinic together with 47 Degrees and Scala Center as its official partners. Our contribution to the community is endorsed by Lightbend.

## Where

Our venue, the Ferreira Borges Market is located in the city's historic center, in the riverside Ribeira district, a part of the UNESCO World Heritage site. Built in 1885 by the Alliance Company (old Massarelos Foundry), the Mercado Ferreira Borges is an important work of cast iron architecture in Porto. Erected by the City to replace the old Ribeira Market, the Ferreira Borges Market was in fact used as a market, but it also served as a setting for other economic functions. In 2017 it will become a focal point of Scala experts and aficionados alike.
